

Dear Friends

We trust that you, your family and friends continue to stay well. As lockdown begins to ease we thought it would be an opportunity to let you know how SCRATCH is doing, what we have been able to restart and how you can help.

The last few months have been a challenge and whilst our paramount concern was keeping our staff and volunteers safe, we were acutely aware that there were many people struggling because we couldn't give them practical help.

We do need to say a huge thank you to Sarah, one of our volunteers, who has kept the office running (on reduced hours) since lockdown started, because staff were shielding or on furlough. With the help of Emma and Lucy (our Welfare Information Officers) over 1200 phone calls were answered in June alone.

During August the office will continue to be open at reduced hours of 9.30am to 2.30pm. We plan to get back to normal hours from September onwards.

DORCAS PROJECT

Following a period of closure, we were able to restart the delivery of furniture at the end of May and recommenced collections in June. However, to comply with government guidelines we cannot carry out as much work as previously because we can only have 2 people in the vehicles, instead of the normal 3. We also need to have fresh PPE for each visit and extra cleaning is required. Quarantining

furniture in the warehouse has been another challenge.

Collections can only be made from a garage, from outside or from one downstairs room. Thank you to everyone for your understanding in this matter. WELFARE LINE

Our welfare line, manned by Emma and Lucy, continues to be busy responding to phone calls from people who are struggling, many of whom have lost work during the COVID pandemic. In March a record 324 calls were dealt with. This has dropped over the last few months down to the more normal level of 136 in June.
